In August 2027, more than 40,000 Scouts and Guides from all over the world will gather for the 26th World Scout Jamboree – this time in **Poland.**

You can join the **Luxembourgish contingent** and participate in the **camp** discovering new cultures, making friendships across borders and simply having an unforgettable time!

The Luxembourgish Contingent

Scouting in Luxembourg (SIL) will head the Luxembourgish contingent, with members from **LGS and FNEL** eligible to become part of the contingent as participants, international service team (IST) and leaders.

Paul Fay (**Tahr**) from FNEL and **Charel Donven** from LGS have jointly taken on the role of **Head of Contingent.**

Together we will plan activities to prepare you all for an unforgettable time at the Jamboree.







How to join?

There are **four roles** open for application:

1. Participants:

- Born between July 30th, 2009, and July 30th, 2013.
- No exceptions possible
- This is a once in a life possibility to join the World Jamboree as a participant.

2. Unit Leaders:

• At least 21 years old by July 29, 2027 (Date of Birth: July 29, 2006, or earlier)

3. Leaders (normal)

- Minimum age: 18 years old by July 29, 2027 (Date of Birth: July 29, 2009, or earlier)
- A unit consists of 36 scouts, a unit leader and three leaders

4. IST – International Service Team

- Minimum age: 18 years old by July 29, 2027 (Date of Birth: July 29, 2009, or earlier)
- You will work in international teams at the Jamboree to ensure that the participants have an unforgettable time a great experience!
- The Luxembourgish contingent is currently preparing a Luxembourgish Food House and if it will be finalized, motivated IST members would be welcome to join the team.

Costs:

Jamboree package:

Participants + Leaders: Maximum €2,100

- Camp fee: € 1,500 € (set by the WSJ)

- Transport: € 250

- Other cost and reserve: € 350

IST: Maximum **€2,000**

- Camp fee: € 1,400 € (set by the WSJ)

- Transport: € 250

- Other cost and reserve: € 350

* The fourth installment will be adjusted depending on the Early Registration discount/IST discount/regular participant cost. In addition, the total price might be adjusted down, depending on the actual cost of the trip.

Payments:

Payments will go via your local scoutgroup, given that are at least three members joining the Jamboree.

Sign up:

Regular sign up will open on September 1st and close on October 18th (23:59)

The registration has to be confirmed by our site for it to be definite! We expect this to happen early or mid-November.

Refund Policy:

- Instalments are due on the dates listed above and are not refundable.
- Exception: If you find a replacement participant that is deemed eligible by the CMT. The CMT team makes the final decision on eligibility and time constraints on replacement participants.
- Potential refunds because of lower costs will be made post camp, after the accounts close.

Why is the cost of the Jamboree so high?

A camp with 40.000 people attending requires logistics and infrastructure to be put in place at the camp site, to ensure the safety of all participants, leaders and IST.

Furthermore, the aim is to make it possible for scouts from the whole world to participate. As living standards differ vastly there are four price categories for the Jamboree, and Luxembourg is in the highest category, enabling scouts from other parts of the world to participate.

In addition to the camp fee, there is the cost of transport, necker and badge, administrative costs and a reserve fund to secure that financial obligations of the trip are met. The Contingent Management Team is working hard to decrease the cost and hopefully we will be able to reduce the price.

As part of the Jamboree experience, the units are expected to plan their own fund raising for participants and leaders alike.

Post-trip:
